Kuwait enjoys sound macroeconomic conditions, reflected in a moderate but sustainable economic growth, financial stability, curtailed inflationary pressures through a prudent monetary policy of its Central Bank, maintaining twin surpluses in its "internal" budgetary balance, and its "external" current account balance. The latest Article IV Consultations with IMF mission to Kuwait was published in May 9, 2011.

• Strong currency sound financial system + active SE

The Kuwaiti Dinar is a strong and stable currency, which reflects the strength of the country's monetary policy, aiming at averting imported inflationary pressures. In the period 1975-end of 2002, the KD was pegged to a basket of currencies, representing its main trading partners of which the U.S. dollar has the most weight. However, Kuwait pegged its currency to the dollar in the period from January 2003 - May 2007, but then Kuwait reverted to peg KD to an undisclosed basket of currencies to avoid imported inflation from the weakened US dollar during that time.

The Central Bank of Kuwait supervises a whole network of banking institutions that include **21 banks of which**

- Branches of non-Kuwaiti commercial banks: The Bank of Bahrain & Kuwait, BNP Paribas Bank, HSBC Middle East Bank, the National Bank of Abu Dhabi, Citibank, the Qatar National Bank, the Doha Bank, the Mashreq Bank, Bank Muscat.
- ▶ Specialized Banks: The Industrial Bank of Kuwait.
- Islamic Banks: Kuwait Finance House, Boubyan Bank, International Bank of Kuwait "previously Kuwait Real Estate Bank", Al-Ahli United Bank "previously the Bank of Kuwait & the Middle East".
- ▶ Branches of non-Kuwaiti Islamic Banks: The branch of Al-Rajhi Bank.

"The Kuwaiti Stock Exchange is the first in the GCC and has been considered one of the most active in the region, with market capitalization reaching more than US\$ 110 billion, and the number of shares traded on average exceeding 22 million in 2010, with 212 listed companies".

Investor Grade in sovereign rating & low political risk

Kuwait enjoys Investor Grade sovereign rating by the major credit rating agencies:

AA (Fitch)

Aa2 (Moody's)

AA- (S&P)

In terms of country credit rating, Kuwait is classified as low risk (A2) by the renown French Coface, which means "the political and economic situation is good. A basically stable and efficient business environment nonetheless leaves room for improvement. Corporate default probability is low on average".

Rating Business climate country rating

A2 A3



The business climate rating is A3 which means: "the business environment is relatively good. Although not always available, corporate financial information is usually reliable. Debt collection and the institutional framework may have some shortcomings. Intercompany transactions may run into occasional difficulties in an otherwise secure environment."

There are no cases of abrupt expropriation or nationalization. The threats to capital and earnings transfer also are non-existent.

FDI Incentives & friendly living environment to foreigners

According to Law no 8 /2001 FDI incentives include:

- exemption from income tax or other taxes for a period not exceeding 10 years from starting actual operation of the enterprise as well as exempting every new investment in the same enterprise from such taxes for a period equivalent to that granted to the original investment when the enterprise was established.
- ▶ Benefit from the privileges supplied under Bilateral treaties (BITS) on the Protections & Encouragement of Investments, and the Avoidance of Double Taxation (DDTs).

Total or partial exemption from customs duties on the following imports:

- ▶ Machinery, equipment, and spare parts required for construction, expansion and development.
- Raw material, semi-processed goods, raping and packing materials and such other materials required for production purposes.
- Allotment of lands and real estate's required for investment purposes in accordance with laws and regulations applicable in the state of Kuwait.
- Recruitment of required foreign labor in accordance with the laws and regulations applicable in the country.

Granting of those privileges is based on several factors including

- ▶ The importance of the sector in the national economic development plans;
- ▶ The number of Kuwaiti workers in the enterprise with due observance of the provisions of the Law no. 19/2000 appointing the national labor
- Location

- Adequate basic & ICT infrastructure + public utilities
- Quality health care, education, shopping, culture & entertainment
- Moderate business costs especially fuel, labour, electricity and water
- Extensive trade relations & agreements (WTO, GCC, GAFTA, BITs & DTTS)
- High degree of deepening integration into the Global Market

Kuwait is considered highly integrated in the global economy because of the following:

- ▶ Kuwait trade (exports + imports) around US\$ 95 billion represents 95% of its GDP.
- ▶ Kuwait Sovereign Wealth Fund manages a US\$ 260 billion investments portfolio in world financial markets.
- Kuwait outward workers' remittances range around US\$ 10 billion annually transferred to various countries designated as pools of human resources in the far East and Arab countries.
- Kuwait is an active member of almost all international organizations and is part of several regional and sub-regional groups with a network of 100 + bilateral agreements and other trade arrangements.
- ▶ Kuwait participated actively in the process of creating global partnerships for development.
- Kuwait enjoys one of the highest rates of official assistance to GDP (1.3%) which is more than the United Nations target of 0.7 %, through Kuwait Fund for Arab Economic Development (KFAED).
- There are 188 countries in the world that received grants from Kuwait in the amount of US 500 million and around 108 countries that received soft term loans more than US\$ 15.6 billion.
- Low Corporate Tax & no Income Tax for Individuals nor other Taxes
- Rich with strategic Oil resources






The "Investing in Kuwait: A Guide for Investment Opportunities in Kuwait" was launched on July 29, 2013 by KPMG Advisory W.L.L. Kuwait for the benefit of and in cooperation with Kuwait Foreign Investment Bureau (KFIB).

The Guide, the first of its kind, provides a general overview of the Kuwaiti economy and its main attributes, as well as sector profiles that reflect potential investment opportunities, and portrays the role of KFIB in servicing investors under FDI Law No. 8 for 2001, relevant other matters, and business forms in the country, ending with several annexes that covers Kuwait economic performance, life in Kuwait, important economic legislations, main stakeholders and their contact details, terminology glossary, and a list of the country's bilateral agreements for the protection & encouragement of investment and avoidance of double taxation.

The Guide has showcased a host of potential investment focusing opportunities on infrastructure, environmental services, downstream-chemical manufacturing, education & training, healthcare, integrated housing projects & urban development, storage & logistics services, banking, financial services & insurance, air, maritime & rail passenger transport, tourism, hotel & entertainment, web & APP development, culture, media & marketing.

A rigorous opportunity assessment process was co-developed based on a scoring model analysis to determine the overall attractiveness rating for the potential opportunities for the sectors that were selected based on a set of strategic guiding principles.

As of June 16, 2013, the passage of Law No. 116 for 2013 regarding the promotion of direct investment in the State of Kuwait has repealed Law No. 8 for 2001 regarding Direct Foreign Capital Investment in the State of Kuwait. Thus all funds, assets, obligations and rights relevant to KFIB were transferred to the newly established Kuwait Direct Investment Promotion Authority (KDIPA). However, this Guide will remain as a useful source of information for investors, and for providing a good basis to develop future guides that will under the new authority.


