Reconstruction of Iraq

- International Conference for the reconstruction of Iraq was held in Kuwait on 12-14 February 2018
- More than 70 countries participated in the conference
- 30 billion USD of additional international support to the country
- The conference focused on the physical and human dimensions of reconstruction

Kurdistan Regional Government (KRG)

- The KRG exercises legislative, executive and judicial powers according to the Kurdistan Region's laws
- The current coalition government, led by Prime Minister Nechirvan Barzani, consists of several political parties that reflect the diversity of the Region's population
- Iraq's Constitution recognises the KRG and the Kurdistan Parliament as the region's formal institutions

Strengths of Kurdistan Region

- a) Large oil & gas resources
- b) Fertile agricultural land
- c) Young population
- d) Relatively stable location



- e) Entrepreneurial spirit of its population
- f) Central location at crossroads of trade routes

Oil and Gas Industry

- The energy sector is the most important of the economy
- 90% of revenues of the Region
- The KRG has signed dozens of production sharing contracts with companies from many countries
- Major international oil companies

Board of Investment (BOI)

Investment Law No 4/2006
It covers all economic sectors except oil and gas

- Provision of land plots for subsidized lease
- Exemption from corporate taxes (10 years) and customs duties (5 years)
- Full repatriation of profits is allowed
- Possible to employ foreign labor

Customs Duties - Corporate tax rates

- The general custom duty rate is 5%
- Several goods are exempted from customs duties
 (such as basic food products, medicines and stationery)
- The corporate income tax rate for all industries is a flat rate of 15%

 Projects licensed by the Board of Investment are exempt from taxes and import tariffs
