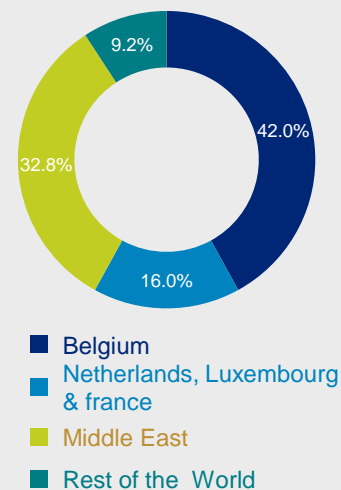
BESIX Group Figures 2013-2017 (in mio EUR)

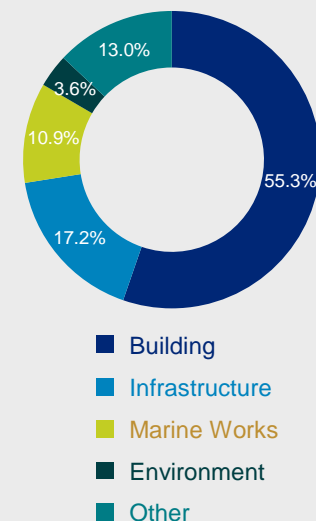
REVENUES 2017

Breakdown by region



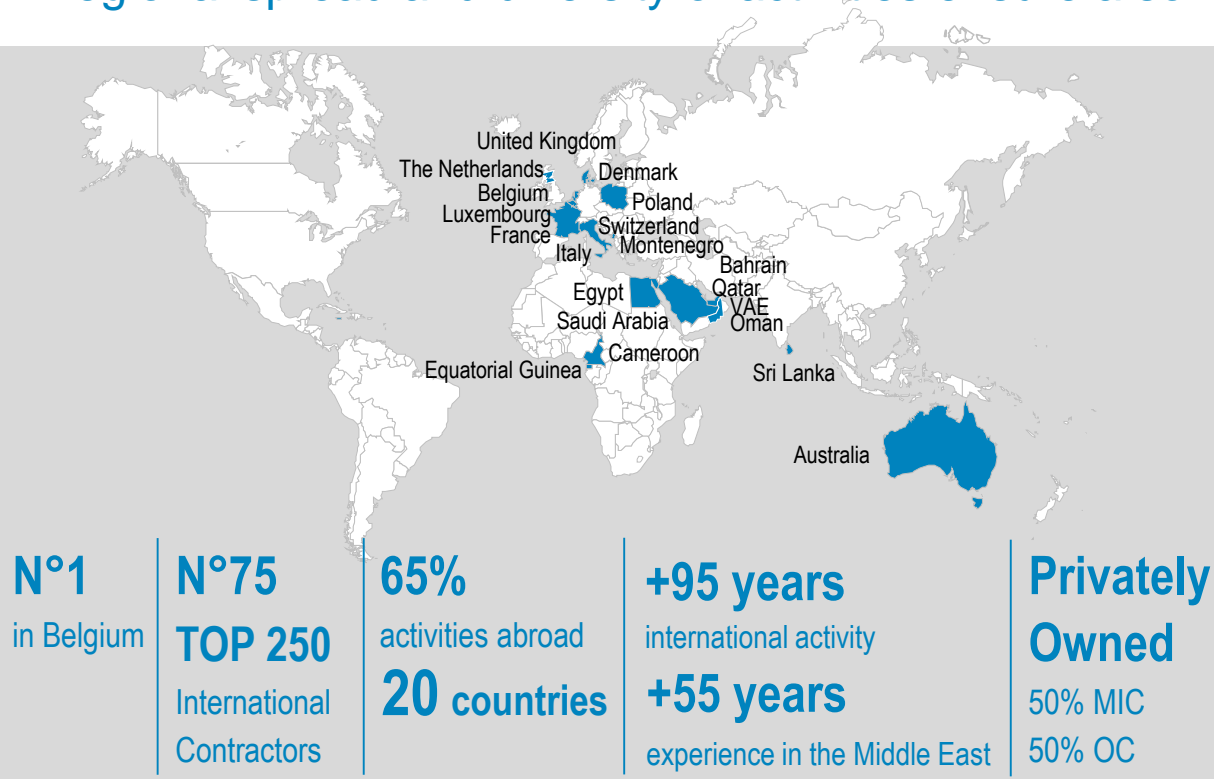
REVENUES 2017

Breakdown by activity

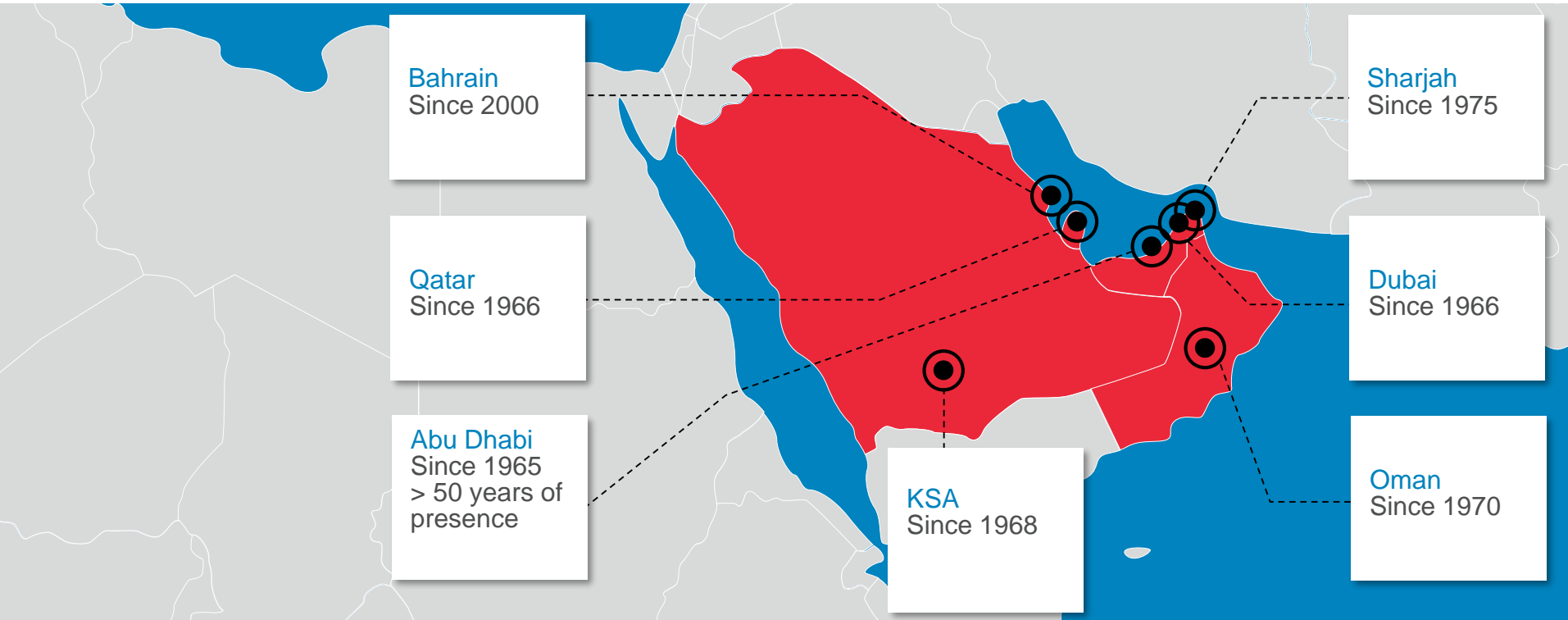

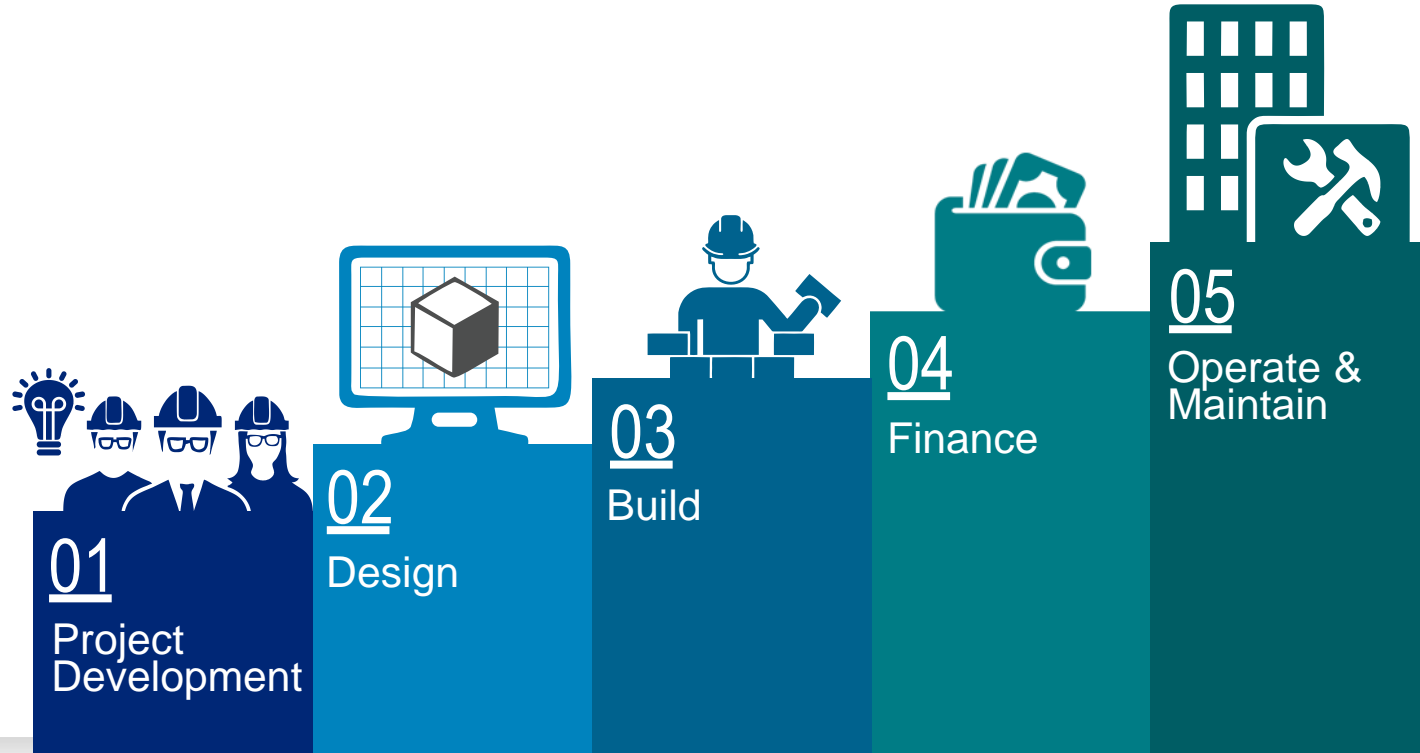

This project of 400,563 m² build area includes 375 medical rooms with exclusive Royal Suites and 324 exam rooms and ambulatory clinics.

Complexities for this project include the installation of very complex data systems, high degree of environmental control for medical surgery quarters and environmental issues concerning medical waste, among others.

A mixed use hotel and residential two-tower complex that rises to a height of 187 meters above the ground. Both towers are connected by a 45 meter long sky bridge and consist each of 3 reinforced concrete sub-towers.

In preparation for Dubai's Expo 2020, the resort is considered one of Dubai's largest projects.
