This estimation does not take into account the destruction of houses during the skirmishes afterwards

Housing in Libya

Most housing projects were put on hold since 2011, according to MHU:

200,000 houses were tasked to be built
94,500 of which were at the bidding phase
11,121 only were at the construction phase in 2012

MHU: Ministry of housings and utilities

Obstacles

Unstable political situation since 2011 Unpredictable skirmishes that became more violent in 2014 Kidnaping, Looting and plundering especially in remote locations Incompetency of local constructions contractors Shortage of raw materials & blue collar jobs

Restoring Libya's infrastructure is estimated at 9 Billion EUR in the next 10 years


