

IDAL enjoys financial and administrative autonomy and reports to the President of the Council of Ministers who exercises a tutorial authority over it.



Lebanon has a government-mandated minimum wage, and no worker in Lebanon can be paid less then this mandatory minimum rate of pay.

The Lebanon minimum wage is **30,000 pounds per day,or 675,000 pounds (\$450)** per month. Lebanon's minimum wage was last changed in 2-Jan-2012.
