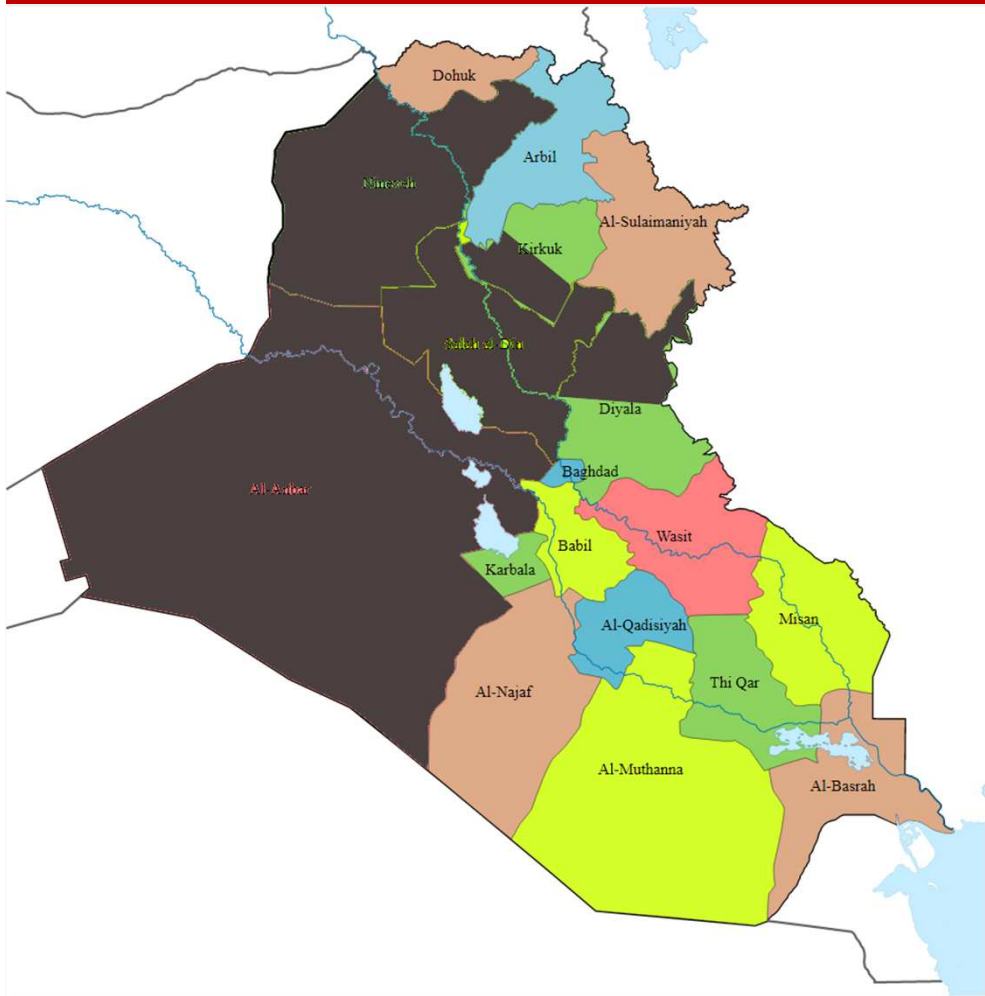

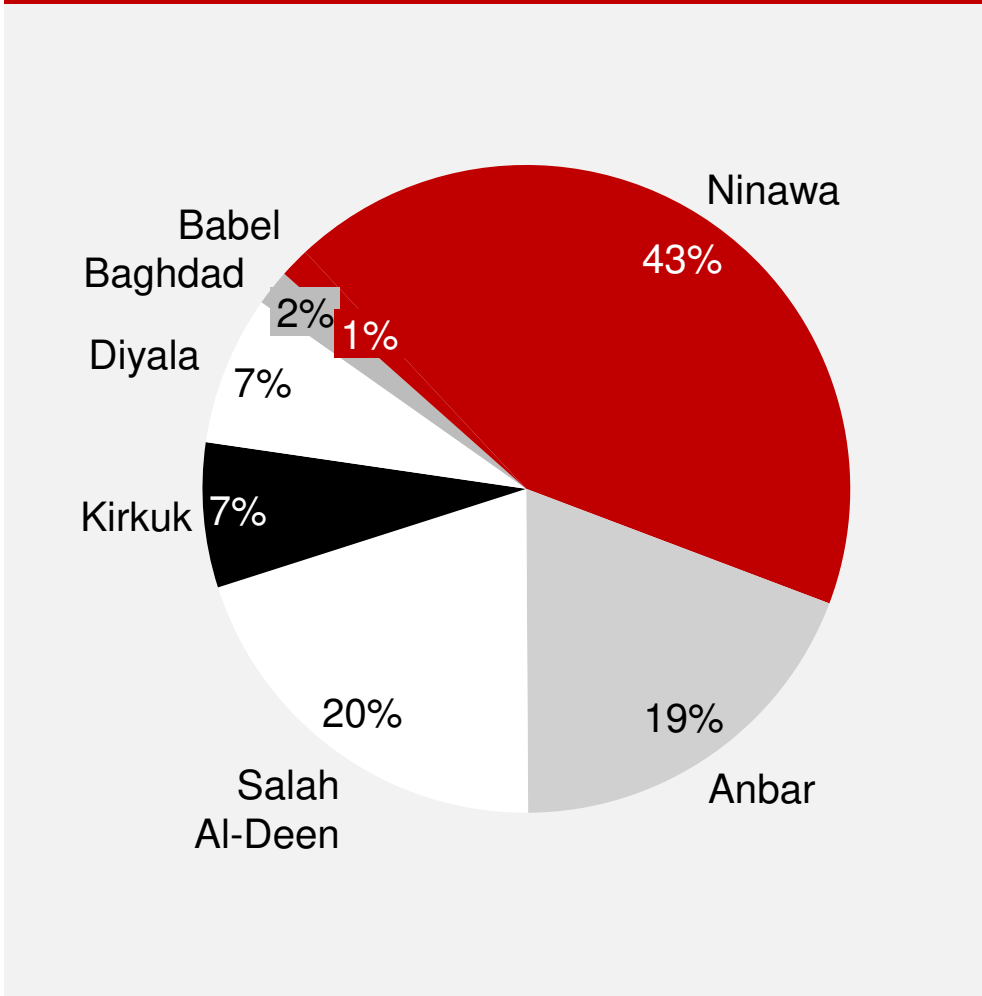

Peak ISIS presence in Iraq in 2015

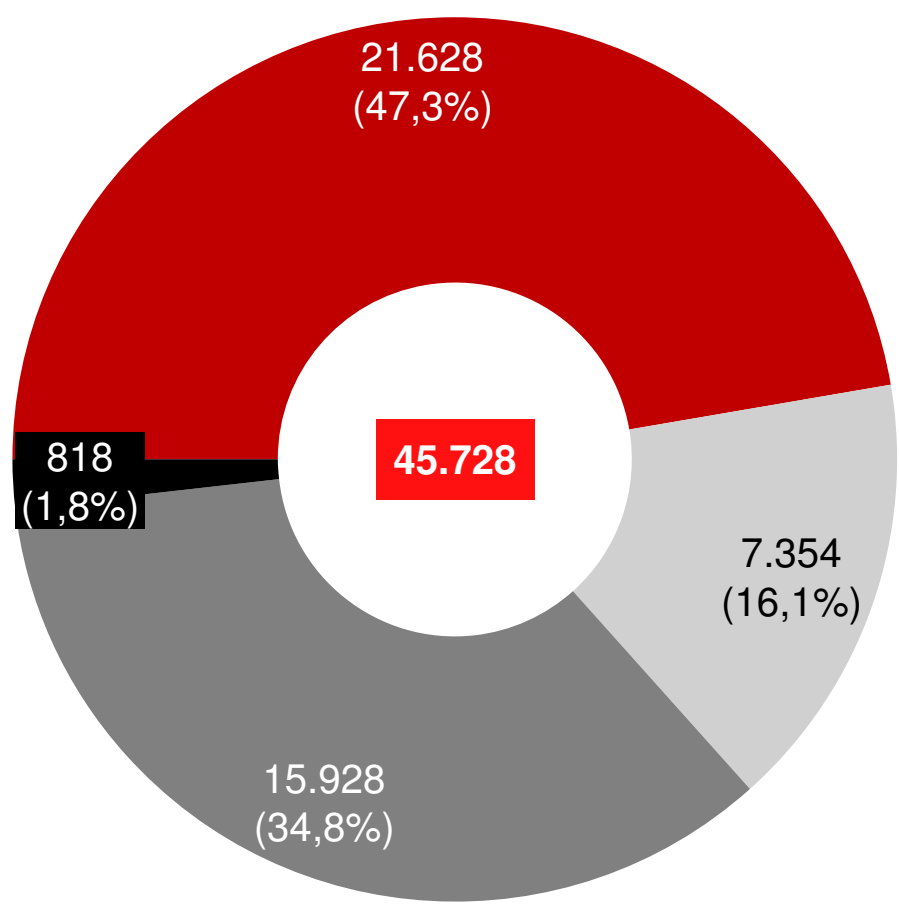


Estimated Damage by Governates



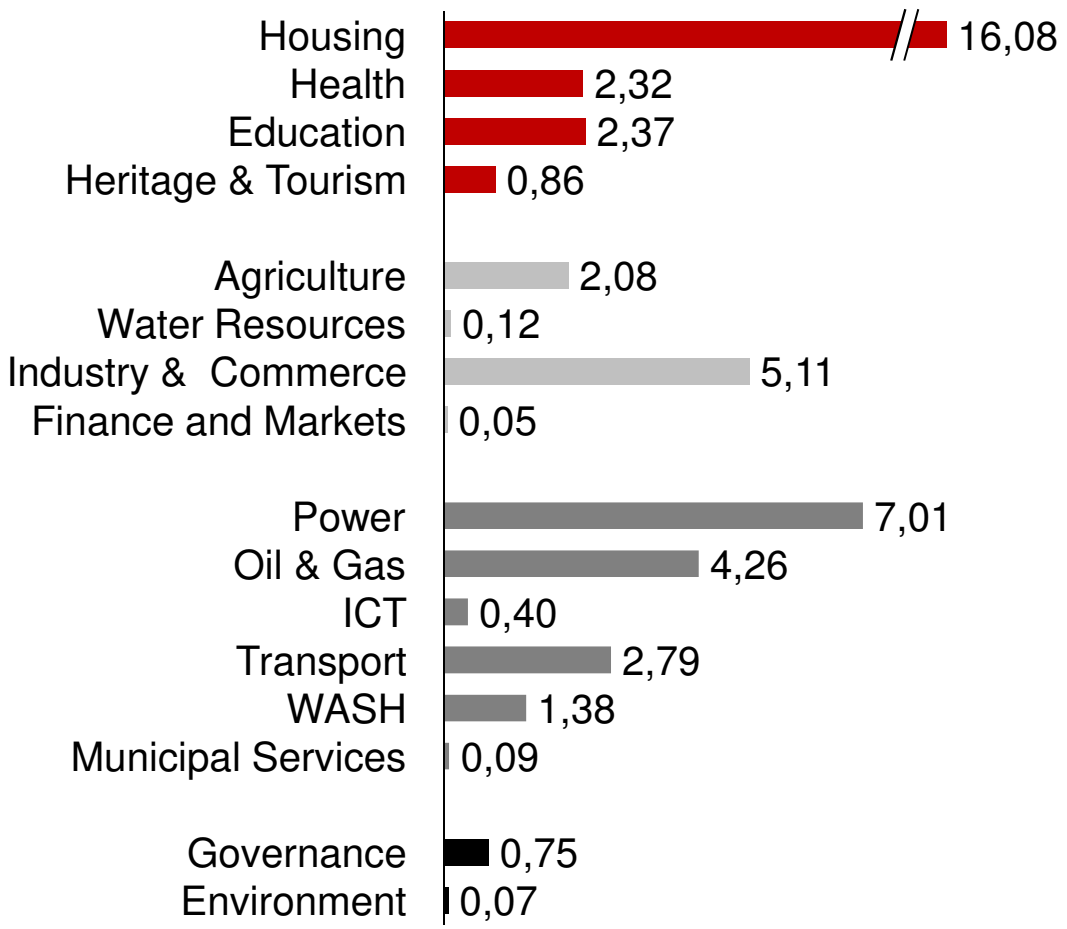

DAMAGE BY SECTORS IN MILLION USD



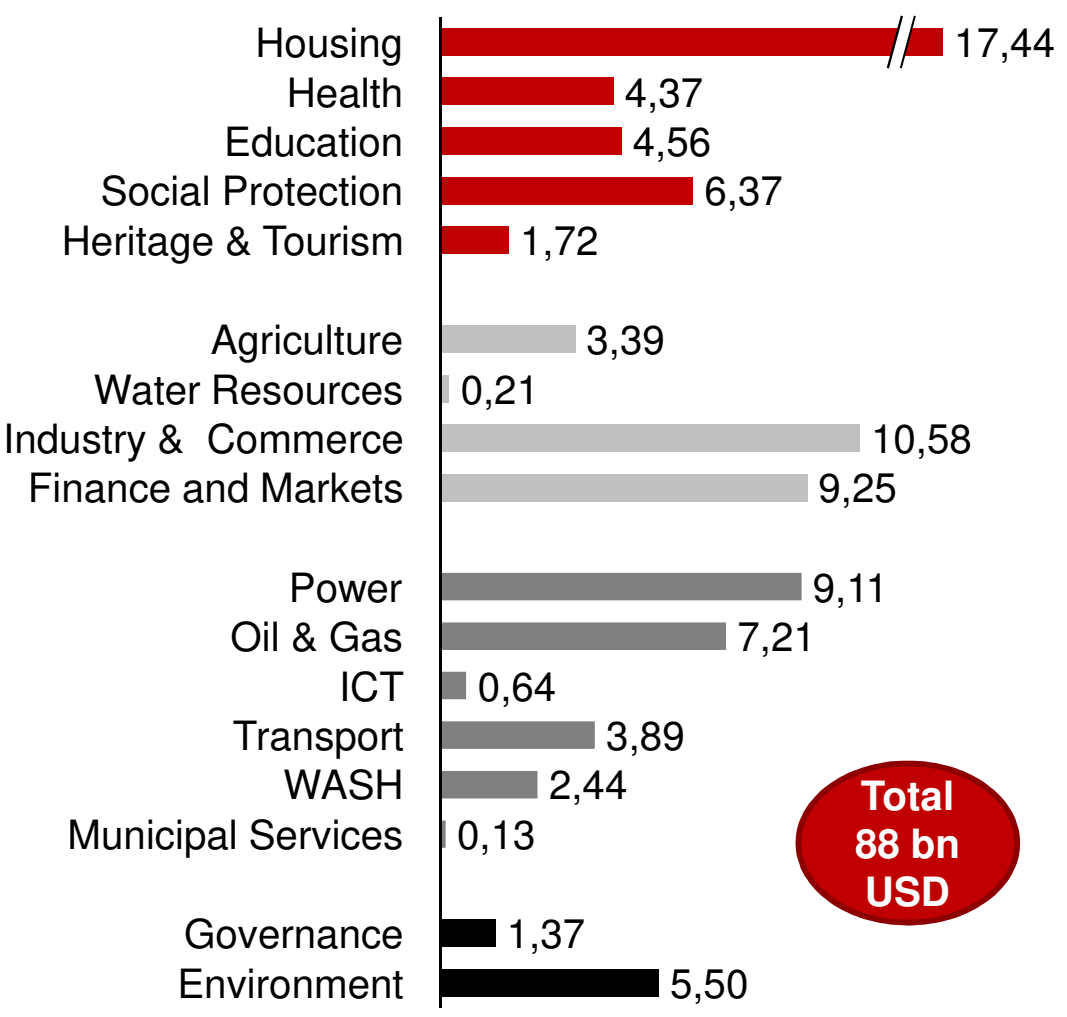

DAMAGE BY CATEGORIES IN BN USD

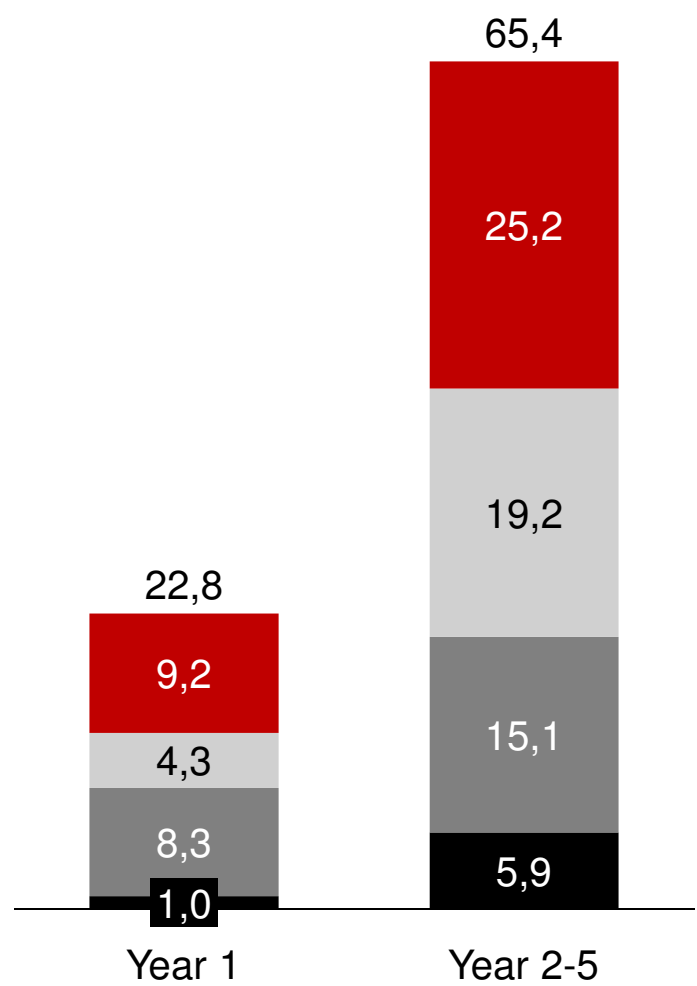

NEEDS BY CATEGORIES IN BN USD



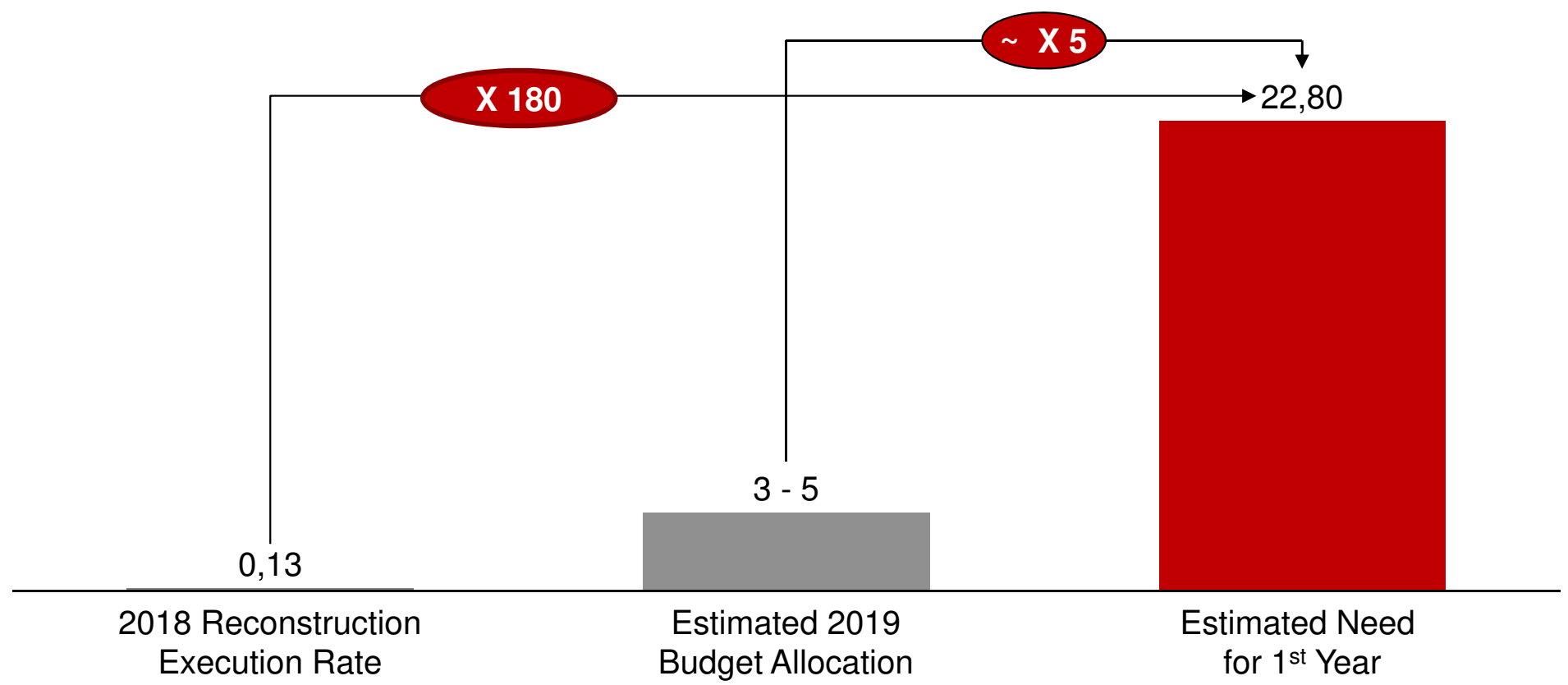
NEEDS BY SECTORS IN BN USD / YEARS

THERE ARE SEVERAL AREAS, WHERE THE EU PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTOR COULD PARTICIPATE AND SUPPORT IN ORDER TO ACCELERATE THE RECONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES

Key areas to accelerate reconstruction activities:

- Structure reconstruction effort in larger program packages
- Accelerate project assessment, planning and budget inclusion
- Improve utilization of international funding facilities
- Increase government project management capacity
- Enable Infrastructure PPP models
- Set conditions for private sector and economic development (incentive for local content)
- Support and fund private reconstruction efforts

Potential EU support areas:

- Provide technical assistance
- Support development of and suggest PPP models
- Support planning and project management activities
- Provide Project delivery capacity
- Provide Innovative technologies to increase execution rate

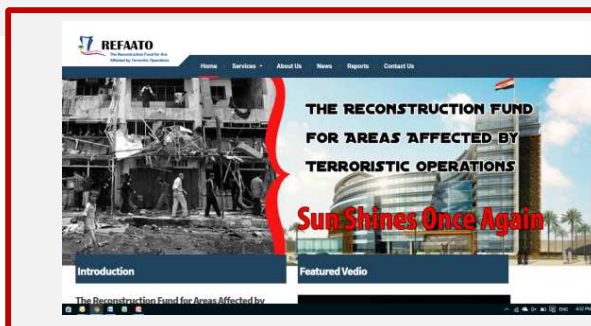
ABOUT REFAATO

The reconstruction fund is organized by a decree No. 237 for 2015 of the cabinet of ministers issuing rules No.(4) for 2015 for the reconstruction fund .

REFAATO RESPONSIBILITIES

- Management of grants from development partners
- Setting projects priorities ,supervision and following implementation of developmental projects in affected governorates
- Coordination with development partners to support the reconstruction process, and proposing plans and policies to achieve the goals of the state in the reconstruction of the affected areas .
