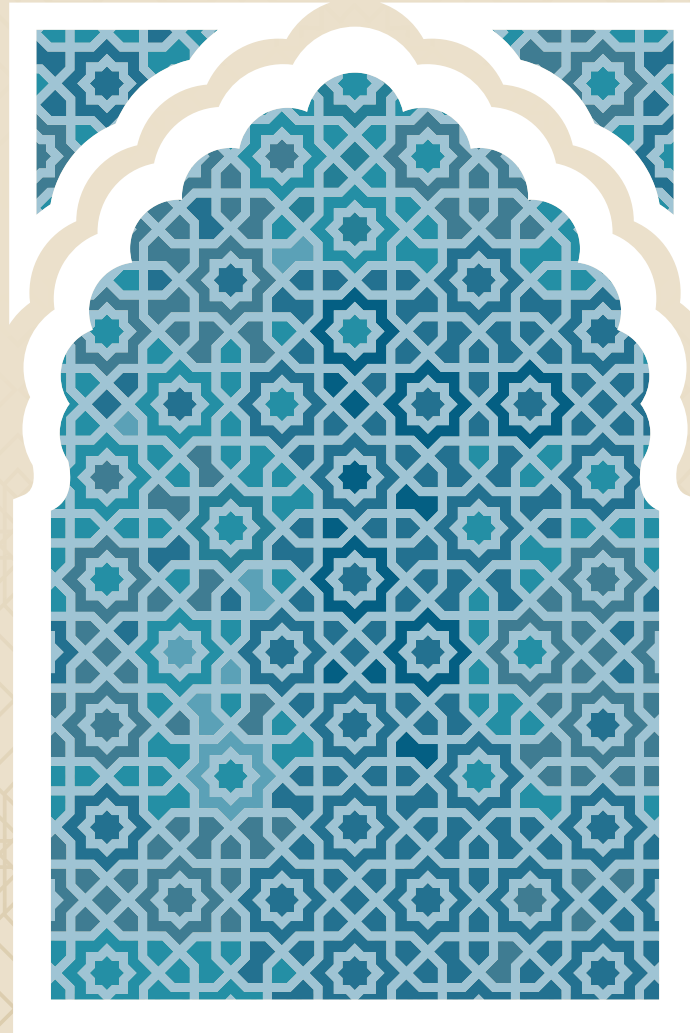

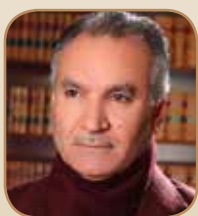

Ambassador Khairat holds a degree in Commerce from the University of Ain Shams, Cairo, Egypt (class of 1984) and he is a father of three sons.

The relations between Egypt and Greece go back to hundreds of years and, throughout history, they have been exemplary in every aspect. In the ERGANI IS the Interest Form for the program "CHOOSE...GREECE" has already been posted.
