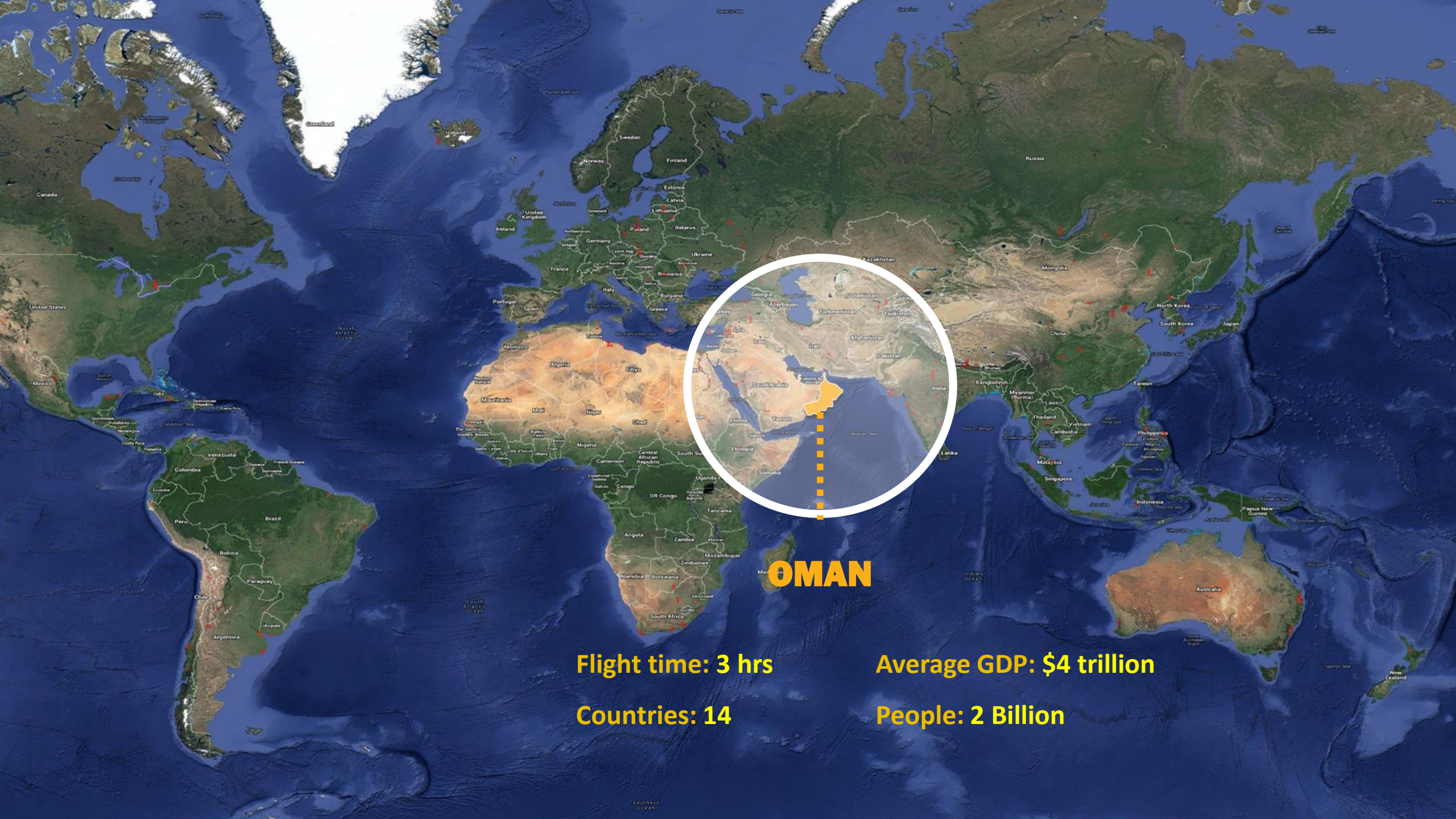

- There is no minimum capital
- Setting a timeframe for approvals and permissions of projects
- No taxes on personal income on individual
- 15% is value of corporate income tax
- Leading advanced telecommunication infrastructure supporting interconnected international and domestic networks
- Additional incentives for projects in less developed areas

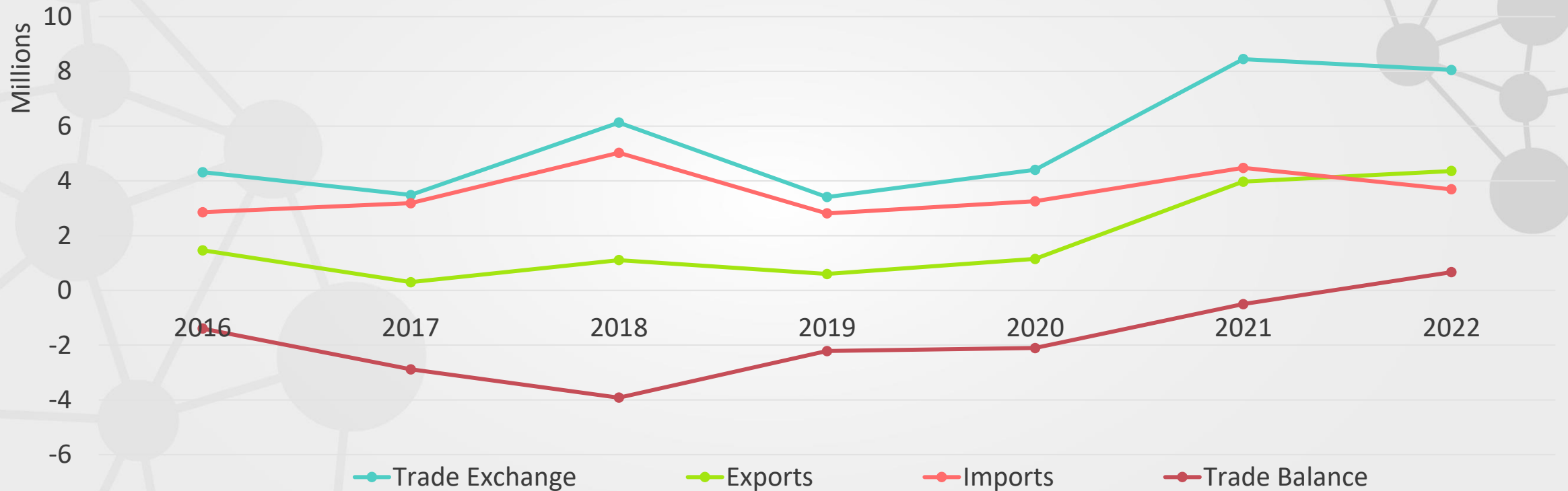

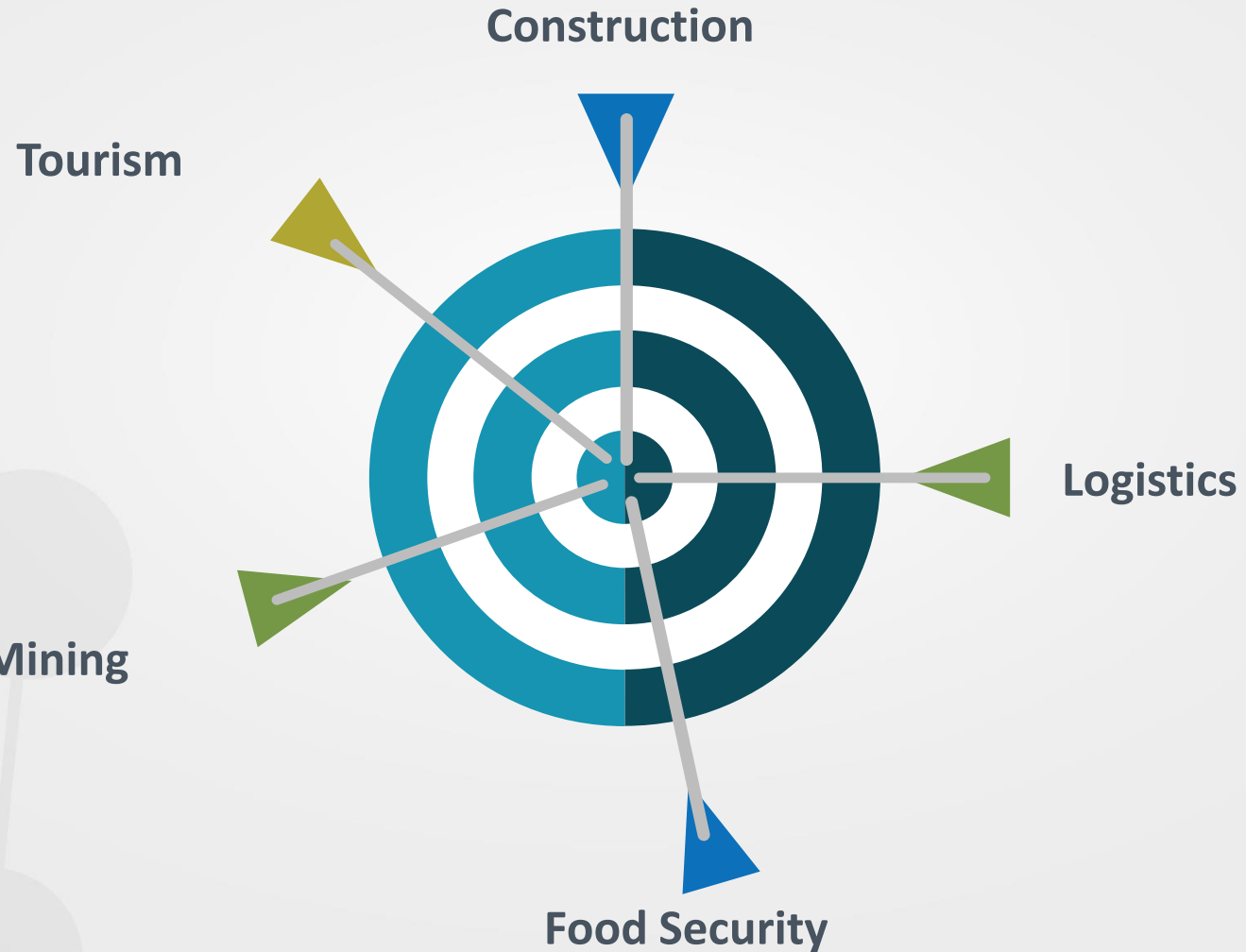

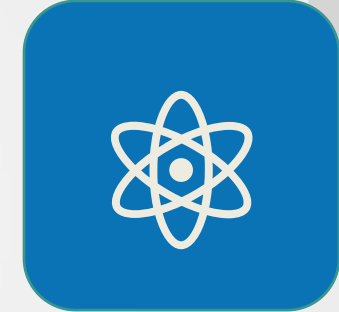

Al Mazunah Free Zone

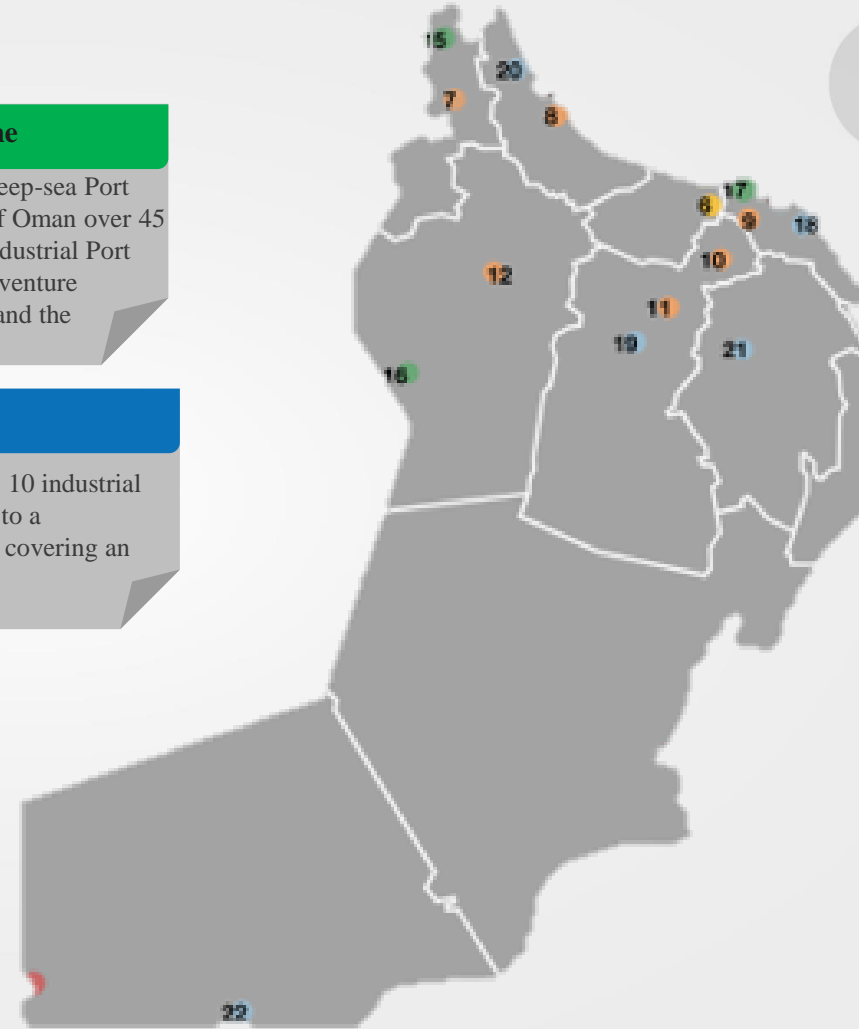
15.3 sq. km land bound free zone mainly to facilitate trade with Yemen and North Africa

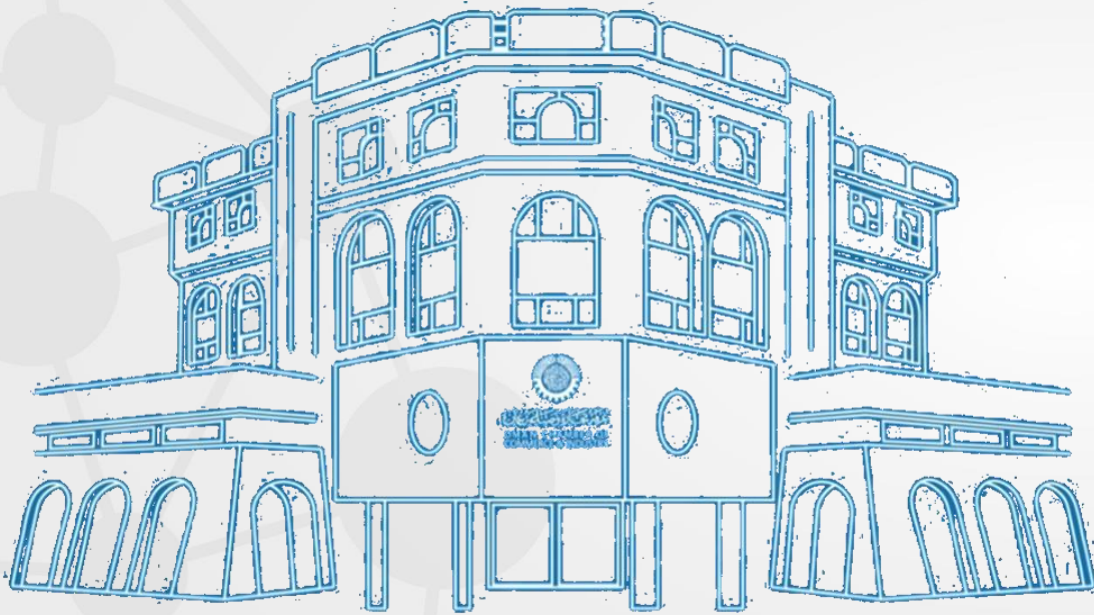
Madayn
