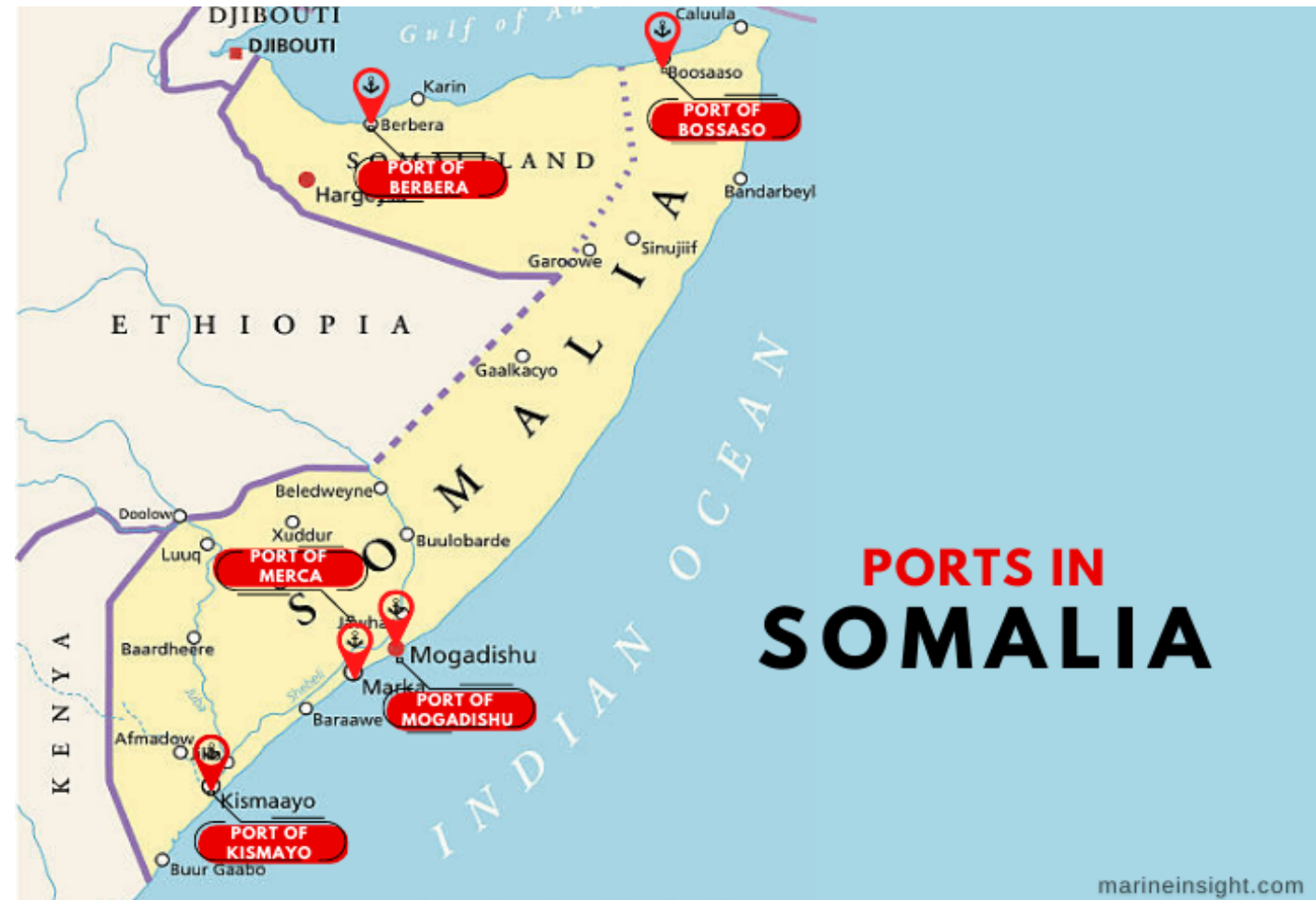




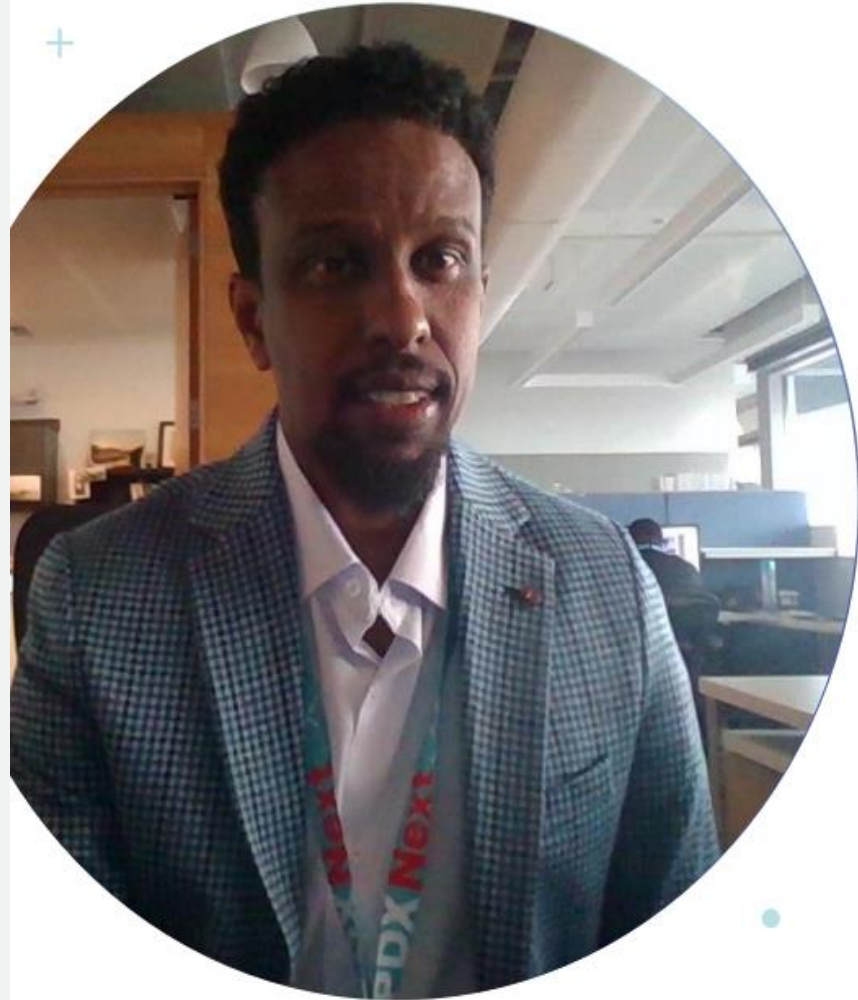

INTRODUCTION

- **LONGEST COASTLINE IN AFRICA AND IN ARABIA**
 - Stretching across an impressive length of approximately 3,333 kilometers, Somalia proudly boasts the longest coastline in Africa and in the Arab World.
- **RICH SEAFARING TRADITION:**
 - Somalis have long been renowned as skilled sailors and navigators, with their maritime heritage influencing their culture, economy, and interactions with neighboring regions.
- **STRATEGIC LOCATION:**
 - Its proximity to major trade routes made it a significant hub for maritime commerce, facilitating cultural exchanges and commercial relationships with merchants from the Arabian Peninsula, India, and beyond.

PORT OF MOGADISHU



- LARGEST PORT OF SOMALIA
 - Surrounded by a huge artificial breakwater stretching 359 m and a 14 m deep navigation channel.
- OPERATIONAL SINCE THE ROMAN EMPIRE
- ONE OF THE LARGEST IN EAST AFRICA
- MODERNIZED EQUIPMENT AND SERVICE
 - Around 12 to 15 container vessels are unloaded at the terminal every month.

PORT OF BERBERA



- ANCIENT PORT ON THE RED SEA
 - The entrance channel is 800 m wide and around 16.5 m deep providing two anchorages
 - Approximately 250,000 tonnes of cargo and more than 130 vessels are handled at the Berbera port every year.
- NEAR BAB-E-MANDEB.
 - Connecting the Gulf of Aden and the Red Sea
 - Shortest sea route to Ethiopia
- NATURAL RESOURCE EXPORTS
 - Marble and limestone are extracted and shipped through the port for export to international markets.
- LIVESTOCK
 - The Port of Berbera serves as an important gateway for livestock exports.
- FOOD TRADE
 - Both imports and exports.
- COMMERCIAL & LOGISISTICS
 - Comprehensive logistics services such as storage, unloading, shipping, and maritime transport.

PORT OF BOSASO

- LOCATED ON THE RED SEA
- BUILT UNDER SOMALIA'S MILITARY REGIME
- SIGNIFICANT BOOST DURING CIVIL WAR ERA
- MAJOR EXPORTS
 - Livestock and agricultural products such as wheat, coffee, sesame, and dates.

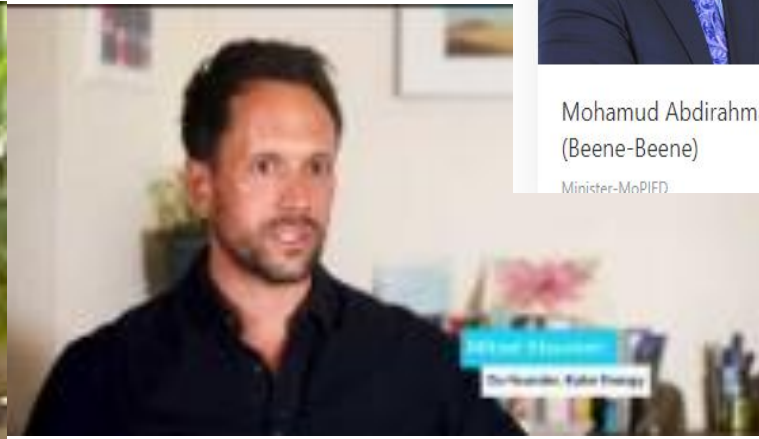
- NEAR KENYAN BORDER ON THE INDIAN OCEAN
