

DESFA's Operation in Kuwait

In October 2020, DESFA was awarded the Operation and Maintenance of the LNGI Terminal in Kuwait Project. The Contract was signed with KIPIC in December 2020, while commencement day was 24th of May 2021 and the commencement of the 1st O&M year was on the 1st of May 2022.

Despite the project's complicated nature and unforeseen challenges encountered throughout the project's implementation, DESFA managed to operate the terminal in a technically efficient way. We have concluded the 1st O&M year and from the 1st of May we have entered to the 2nd O&M year of the project


KPIs performance
