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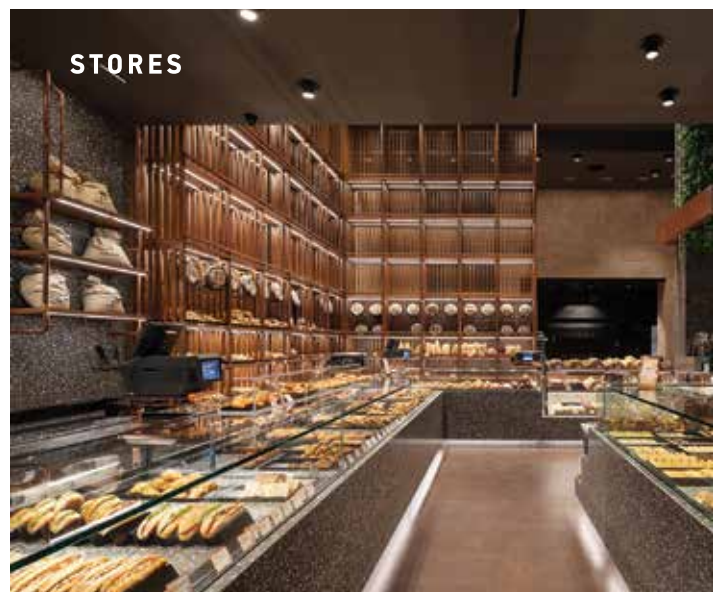

Dear Reader,

General Outlook:

Building on the success of its inaugural edition in May 2024, the Arab Hellenic Chamber is pleased to announce the convening of the “**2nd Arab-Hellenic Health Conference**” on 10–11 June 2026 in Athens, Greece, under the theme: “**Cooperation for a Health-y Future**”. This conference will bring together industry leaders, stakeholders, and experts to explore the emerging trends and developments and the potential of Arab-Greek cooperation in the pharmaceutical and healthcare sectors.

Over the two days, participants will engage in discussions and deliberations on the strategic importance of the pharmaceutical industries, hospital development and modernization, artificial intelligence and digital innovations in diagnosis and treatment, the growth of medical tourism, the cosmetic industry, and entrepreneurs’ ideas and innovations relevant to these sectors.

Interview with Mr. Dimitris P. Giannakopoulos - President BoD & CEO VIANEX S.A.

In this issue of our Chamber's MAN Magazine, we are pleased to publish an interview with Mr. Dimitris P. Giannakopoulos - President BoD & CEO VIANEX S.A. In his answers, Mr. Giannakopoulos shares milestones of his company's journey, and the ongoing family legacy that stemmed from his beloved father, Pavlos Giannakopoulos, and continues today via the Foundation that honors his name and lost-lasting heritage. Through initiatives of social responsibility, Mr. Giannakopoulos, proves to be a visionary with a commitment to contributing to the Greek society in various ways.

VIANEX has evolved from a century-old family pharmacy into a global pharmaceutical manufacturer exporting to over 100 countries. Which core values from your family's legacy continue to guide your decision-making, and how do you balance honoring that heritage with driving innovation?

VIANEX's journey from a small family pharmacy to a pharmaceutical manufacturer exporting to more than 100 countries has always been guided by a clear set of values inherited from our founder, Pavlos Giannakopoulos. At the heart of this legacy is a deeply human-centered philosophy. He strongly believed that our greatest asset is our people, and this principle continues to shape every strategic and operational decision we make today.

Respect for the patient remains central to our approach,





influencing every stage of our work, from production and quality standards to the final product that reaches pharmacies and hospitals. This commitment to people, trust, and responsibility is what has allowed us to build long-term relationships and maintain our position in a highly demanding global industry.

At the same time, honoring our heritage does not mean standing still. Our strategic priority is continuous progress through innovation. We are consistently investing in the modernization of our production facilities, expanding international partnerships, integrating new technologies, and broadening our activities into new healthcare product categories. These initiatives are essential to our vision of positioning VIANEX among the leading pharmaceutical manufacturers in Europe.

The balance between legacy and innovation comes from maintaining the same core values while evolving with the needs of modern healthcare. By preserving our human-centered culture across generations, we are able to build

on past successes, address challenges more effectively, and continue moving forward with stability, ambition, and a long-term perspective.

You assumed leadership during one of Greece's most severe economic crises, yet still spearheaded significant international expansion. What lessons in resilience and opportunity can business leaders in emerging markets draw from your experience?

Assuming leadership during Greece's prolonged economic crisis was an extremely demanding period, particularly for the pharmaceutical industry, which was heavily affected by severe reductions in public healthcare spending and measures such as the clawback system, which unfortunately remains in place today. However, difficult periods can also become defining moments for businesses, shaping both their resilience and long-term vision.

One of the most important lessons from our experience is that in times of crisis, companies must remain

committed to their people. Despite the intense economic pressure, VIANEX protected jobs and salaries, because we believed that preserving trust, stability, and human capital was essential for the company's future.

Another key lesson is the importance of outward-looking strategy. VIANEX already had a strong export orientation before the crisis, and this international presence became a critical growth driver during those difficult years. Today, we export to more than 100 countries, while also expanding our regional footprint through the establishment of local offices across the Balkans.

For business leaders in emerging markets, I believe the message is that they should encourage adaptability, strategic investment, and international expansion. Companies that continue investing in innovation, maintain strong relationships with their people, and remain focused on long-term goals are the ones that emerge stronger and more competitive when the crisis subsides.



Your portfolio spans pharmaceuticals, health supplements, digital media (DPG Group), and professional sports (Panathinaikos B.C.). How do these seemingly distinct sectors create strategic synergies and reinforce one another?

Although these sectors may appear very different on the surface, they are connected by a common philosophy and a shared ambition for excellence. In two of these fields, pharmaceuticals and Panathinaikos B.C., I have chosen to continue a strong family legacy, one built on passion, commitment, and the pursuit of leadership.

The common ground on pharmaceuticals, digital media, and professional sports is our determination to operate at the highest level. VIANEX holds a leading position in the Greek pharmaceutical industry, ahead even of multinational companies operating in Greece. Panathinaikos B.C. is one of the most successful and historic basketball clubs in both Greece and Europe, while DPG Digital Media has established a leading presence in the production of credible, original, and meaningful content, as well as in the development of integrated advertising solutions.

Beyond performance and market leadership, these



sectors reinforce one another through a shared strategic approach: continuous progress through innovation, investment in infrastructure and people, and the expansion of international partnerships. Whether we are talking about healthcare, media, or sports, success ultimately depends on vision, discipline, teamwork, and the ability to adapt to evolving environments.

Most importantly, all these activities have a broader social dimension. Through healthcare, we contribute to improving people's quality of life; through sports, we promote values such as teamwork, discipline, and excellence; and through media, we support responsible information and public dialogue. At the end of the day, our goal is to create organizations that make a meaningful contribution to Greek society and that people can genuinely be proud of.

Social responsibility remains a cornerstone of your group, carried forward through the Pavlos Giannakopoulos Foundation. Could you highlight key initiatives, such as hospital support, medical donations, and scholarships for young scientists, and explain how these efforts reflect your broader vision for sustainable impact in Greek society?

Social responsibility has always been an integral part of VIANEX's philosophy and values. Through the Pavlos Giannakopoulos Foundation we continue to invest in initiatives that promote health, social cohesion, and long-term progress in Greek society.

We have consistently supported patient associations and strengthened public healthcare infrastructure through targeted donations and medical support, always aiming to improve people's quality of life.

At the same time, we believe that social welfare must be approached in a broader and more sustainable way. One of the most critical challenges facing Greece today is the demographic crisis and declining birth rate. We consider this issue to be of national importance, which is why we have placed it at the center of our recent initiatives.

We recently completed a program supporting families



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living in Greece's remote border regions who welcomed a third child or more. 160 families received financial support for each birth, helping them cover essential needs and easing the burden on young families living in isolated areas.

In addition, since 2020 we have partnered with the non-profit organization Be-Live to support couples facing both reproductive and financial difficulties. Through this collaboration, we fully cover the cost of IVF procedures for couples living in remote regions of Greece who otherwise would not have access to such opportunities. The program began in Samos, later expanded to Patmos, and is currently continuing in Sparta for a second consecutive year, a location of special emotional significance for us, as it is closely connected to the origins of the Giannakopoulos family.

These initiatives reflect our broader vision of creating sustainable social impact: supporting healthcare, strengthening families and local communities, and contributing meaningfully to the future resilience and prosperity of Greek society.

Greece has long served as a cultural and commercial bridge between Europe and the Arab world. How can Greek pharmaceutical and health companies position themselves as trusted, high-quality partners for Arab markets seeking European-standard production and innovation?

Greek pharmaceutical and healthcare companies are uniquely positioned to serve as trusted partners for Arab markets, building on the long-standing cultural and economic ties between Greece and the Arab world. In recent years, trade relations have strengthened significantly, with pharmaceuticals emerging — alongside agricultural products — as one of Greece's leading exports to Arab countries.

This success is largely driven by the strong reputation of Greek pharmaceutical manufacturers for producing high-quality, safe, and reliable medicines that meet strict European standards. At the same time, Greek healthcare companies broadly operate under certified best practices, reinforcing confidence in the quality and consistency of their services and products.

Beyond exports, the healthcare sector offers a privileged field for deeper collaboration and knowledge transfer. Greek companies can contribute not only through production capabilities, but also through research and development partnerships, technological expertise, and innovation-driven healthcare solutions. By combining European-standard manufacturing with flexibility, scientific know-how, and a long tradition of trust with Arab partners, Greece can further strengthen its role as a strategic healthcare bridge between Europe and the Arab world.



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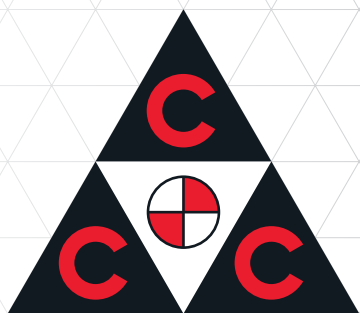
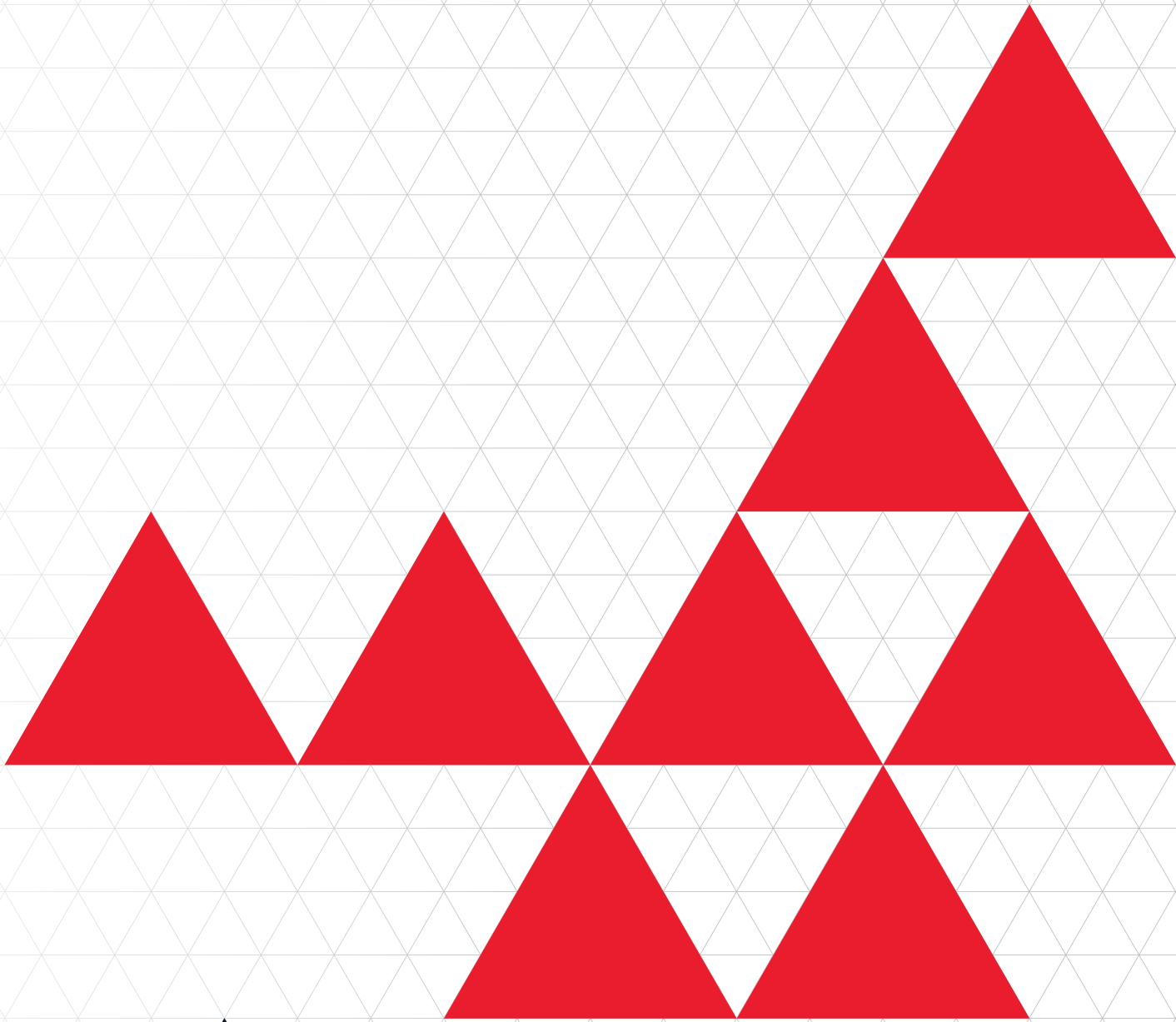

الإضافة الأخرى في برنامج المؤتمر هي التوسّع في موضوع ندرة المواد الخام الداخلة في الصناعات الدوائية، وهي ندرة تمثّل تحدياً ليس للجانب اليوناني وحده، بل للجانب العربي أيضاً، إذ تحتكر دول معدودة كالصين والهند والولايات المتحدة هذه المصادر. هناك مبادرات عربية واعدة في هذا الشأن، من خلال تأسيس شركات متخصصة في البحث عن توفير هذه المصادر في كلٍّ من مصر والمملكة العربية السعودية. وإن كانت هذه المحاولات لا تزال في بداياتها، إلا أننا نعتقد أن الموارد الطبيعية التي يدخر بها العالم العربي في مساحاته الواسعة، من نباتات ومعادن ومصادر أخرى، لا بد أن تُفضي إلى نتائج مبشرة في هذا الخصوص.

تجدد الإشارة هنا إلى أن فكرة عقد مؤتمر للصحة يجمع العرب واليونانيين يعود فضلها إلى السيدة Julia Tsetis، الرئيس والرئيس التنفيذي لمجموعة Tsetis Pharmaceutical، وعضو مجلس إدارة الغرفة العربية اليونانية، التي أطلقت هذه الفكرة ورعتها بأن يُعقد المؤتمر مرةً كل سنتين. وقد حظيت النسخة الأولى من "مؤتمر الصحة العربي اليوناني الأول" في 2024 بإقبال ومشاركة واسعة، ضمت وفوداً رفيعة المستوى من أكثر من 16 دولة عربية ومن اليونان. ولذلك، فإننا متفائلون اليوم بما ستُسفر عنه النسخة الثانية من نتائج، لا سيما أن موظفي الغرفة العربية اليونانية بذلوا جهوداً مخلصاً في الإعداد والتنظيم لهذا المؤتمر.

لا يزال في مرحلة مبكرة نسبياً من الإعداد للفعالية الرئيسية للغرفة العربية اليونانية، "المنتدى الاقتصادي العربي اليوناني الخامس عشر"، المتوقع عقده في 25 و26 نوفمبر. وفي إطار هذا المنتدى، نعقد الدورة الخامسة من لقاء العمل "اليونان ودول مجلس التعاون الخليجي". وثمة أفكار مطروحة حول المنتدى وهذا اللقاء، إن استطعنا تطبيقها، تبدو واعدة بنتائج مثمرة، وبذلك تكون فعالية أخرى تُضاف إلى سجل الغرفة العربية اليونانية في تميّزها وأدائها وحضورها البارز في اليونان، البلد المضيف.

ختاماً، تجمعنا بأعضاء الغرفة العربية اليونانية علاقات وطيدة، وننتهز هذه المناسبة لنعرب عن صادق التقدير للشركات الأعضاء التي أسهمت في رعاية "مؤتمر الصحة العربي-اليوناني الثاني"، ونتطلع إلى أن نخرج بما يعود بالنفع والفائدة على المشاركين، وفي تعزيز التعاون بين بلادنا العربية واليونان.
